Materials:

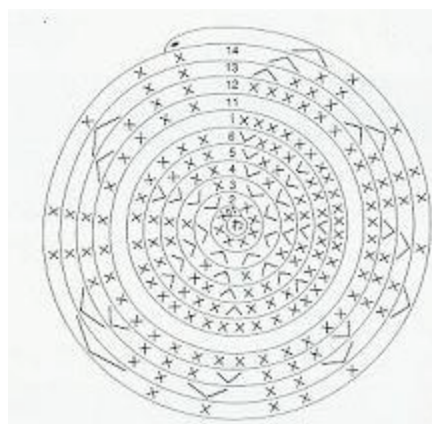
Size "F" crochet hook
Worsted Weight yarn (tan and off white)
Small amount of fabric for bandana
Yarn needle

Note: This pattern is done in the round. Do not join rounds unless otherwise noted.

Head:

Ch 2

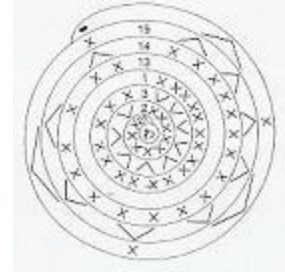
1. 7 sc in the 2nd ch from hook (7)
2. 2 sc in each sc around (14)
3. 2 sc in the first sc, 1 sc in the next sc around (21)
4. 2 sc in the first sc, 2 sc in the next sc around (28)
5. 2 sc in the first sc, 3 sc in the next sc around (35)
- 6-11. sc in each sc around (35)
12. sc next 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc around (28)
13. sc next 2 sc tog, sc in the 2 sc around (21)
14. sc next 2 sc tog, sc in the next sc around (18)



Body:

Ch 2.

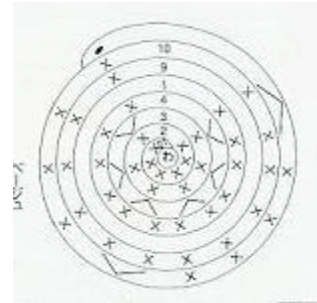
1. 9 sc in the 2nd ch from hook (9)
2. 2 sc in each sc around (18)
- 3-13. sc in each sc around (18)
14. sc next 2 sc tog around (9)
15. sc next 2 sc tog, sc in the next sc around (6)



Ears (Make 2):

Ch 2.

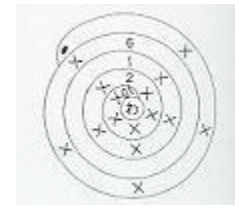
1. 6 sc in the 2nd ch from hook (6)
2. sc in each sc around (6)
3. 2 sc in each sc around (12)
- 4-9. sc in each sc around (12)
10. sc next 2 sc tog, sc in the next 4 sc around (10)



Legs and Tail (make 5):

Ch 2

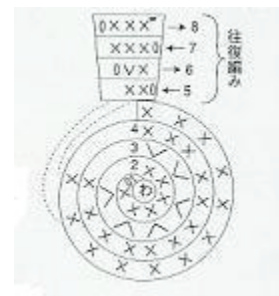
1. 5 sc in the 2nd ch in hook (5)
- 2-6. sc in each sc around (5)



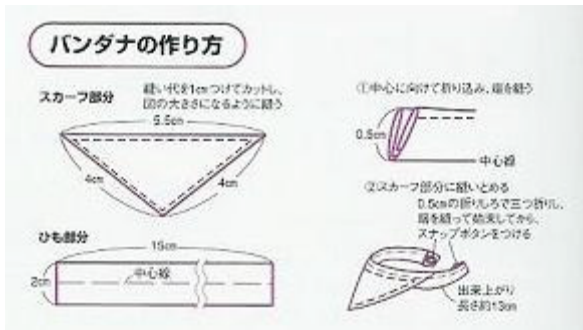
Muzzle:

Ch 2

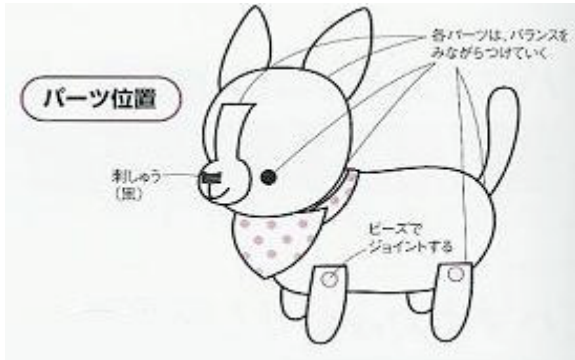
1. 6 sc in the 2nd ch from hook (6)
2. 2 sc in each sc around (12)
- 3-4. sc in each sc around (12)
5. ch 1, sc in the next 2 sc (12)
6. ch 1, turn, 2 sc in the next sc, sc in next sc. (3)
7. ch 1, turn, sc in the next three sc (3)
8. ch 1, turn, sc in the next three sc. (3)



To make the bandana, just use a scrap of fabric and follow the directions on the picture.



Assembly, Assemble as shown
